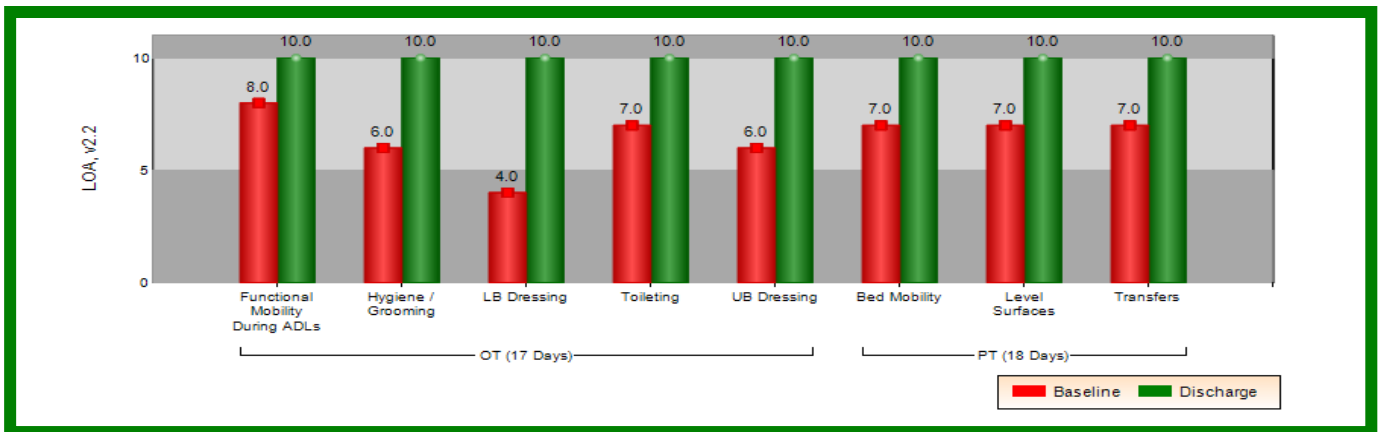

Celebration of success story

Don was admitted to Arista Care at Woodland Park after a hospitalization at UMPC for an enlarged lung nodule. Don underwent a lung resection. Don has received short term rehabilitation previously at Arista Care at Woodland Park with favorable outcomes. He participated in physical and occupation therapy treatments 5-7 times a week for 18 days in order to address the following functional declines: strength, transfers, ambulation, upper/lower body bathing/dressing, balance deficits, and inability to perform cooking/homemaking tasks.

PROGRESS OVERVIEW

Physical Therapy

- Transfers and ambulation: Minimal Assistance level on even surfaces to an independent level with use of a rolling walker. Bed mobility: Minimal assistance to Independent level upon discharge to home;

Occupational Therapy

- Lower body dressing and bathing: Moderate Assistance level to an Independent level;
- Upper body dressing and bathing: Minimal Assistance level to an Independent level;
- Toileting and hygiene/grooming: Minimal Assistance to Independent;
- Functional mobility with ADLs and Self care activities overall from Minimal assistance to Independent upon discharge to home;
