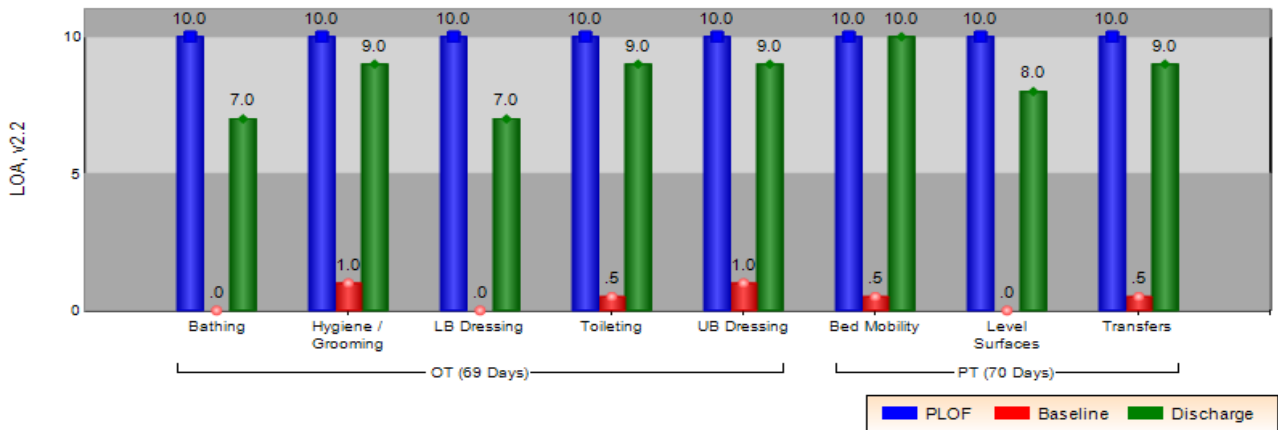

Celebration of success story

David was admitted to Arista Care at Woodland Park after a hospitalization status post sustaining a fall at home. David with diagnosed with a right femur and patellar fracture. David underwent a closed reduction and pinning of the right femur. The physician ordered a knee brace to be worn. Paul participated in physical and occupational therapy treatments 5-7 times a week for 31 days in order to address the following functional declines: strength, transfers, ambulation, upper/lower body bathing/dressing, balance, and safety awareness.

FUNCTIONAL OUTCOME MEASURES – REHAB



PROGRESS OVERVIEW

Physical Therapy

- Transfers and ambulation: Maximal Assistance level on even surfaces to a Supervision level with use of a rolling walker. Bed mobility: Maximal Assistance to Independent level upon discharge to home.

Occupational Therapy

- Lower body dressing and bathing: Maximal Assistance level to a Supervision level;
- Upper body dressing and bathing: Moderate Assistance level to an Independent level;
- Toileting and hygiene/grooming: Maximal Assistance to Supervision;
- Functional mobility with ADLs and Self care activities overall from Maximal Assistance to Supervision level upon discharge to home with family support.
