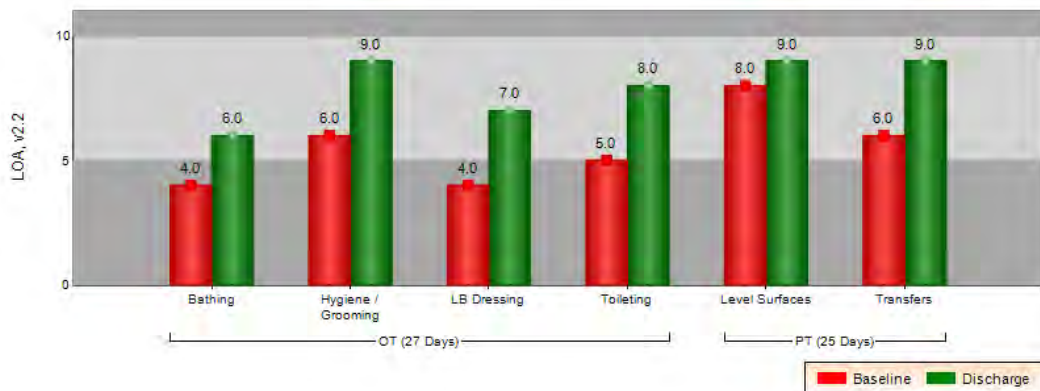

Jane received Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy 5 – 7 days per week to address functional mobility, gait, self care, stair climbing and safety skills. Jane achieved her Speech Therapy goals of short term memory skills and thought organization. In Occupational Therapy she was able to demonstrate independence with bathing, dressing and light housekeeping tasks through increased upper body strength and endurance training. Physical Therapy focused with Jane on lower body strengthening and transfers as well as improved safety and independence with ambulation. Jane achieved her goals and was able to return home independently with her son.

FUNCTIONAL OUTCOME MEASURES – REHAB



- 10.0 - Independent:** Independent with all components of task, with or without assistive device
- 9.0 - Supervision:** Supervision and/or cueing required to complete task
- 8.0 - Contact Guard Assist:** Hands-on cueing / guiding required to complete task
- 7.0 - Contact Guard / Minimal Assist:** Requires less than 30% assist to complete task
- 6.0 - Minimal Assist:** Requires 30% - 39% assist to complete task
- 5.0 - Minimal / Moderate Assist:** Requires 40% - 49% assist to complete task
- 4.0 - Moderate Assist:** Requires 50% - 59% assist from one caregiver to complete task
- 3.0 - Moderate Assist of 2 People:** Requires 60% - 69% assist from two caregivers to complete task
- 2.0 - Moderate / Maximal Assist:** Requires 70% - 79% assist to complete task
- 1.0 - Maximal Assist:** Requires 80% - 89% assist of one caregiver to complete task
- 0.5 - Maximal Assist of 2 People:** Requires 90% - 99% assist of two caregivers to complete task
- 0.0 - Total Dependence:** Does not attempt to initiate task

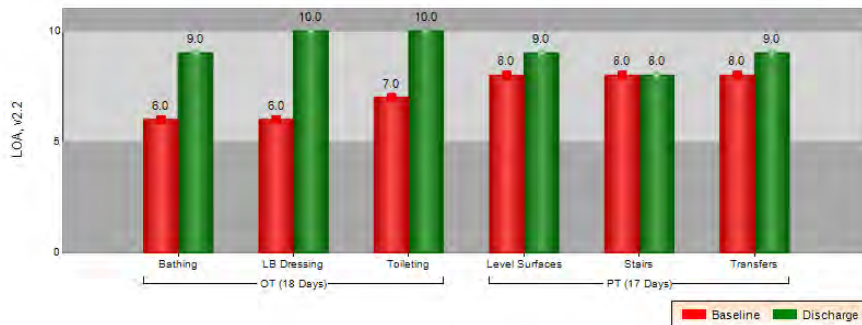

Alan received Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy 5-6 days per week to address functional mobility, transfers, gait, self care, stair climbing, balance, memory and safety skills. Alan progressed towards his goals in Occupational Therapy, he was able to demonstrate supervision with bathing, independence with toileting and dressing through increased upper body strength and endurance training. Physical Therapy focused with Alan on lower body strengthening, trunk strengthening, transfer training, balance activities, stair climbing as well as gait training. Alan progressed towards his goals and was able to return home at his prior level of function. Speech Therapy assisted Alan to improve his accuracy with thought organization and multi step task sequencing, as well as independence with medication management. Alan progressed towards his goals and was able to return home with his family and an assistive device, right hand splint and home exercise program.

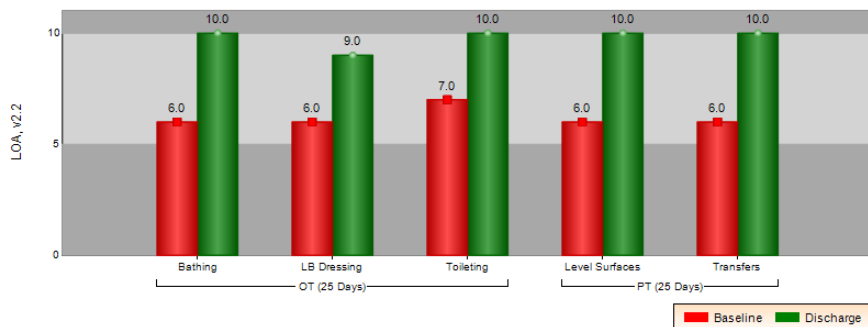

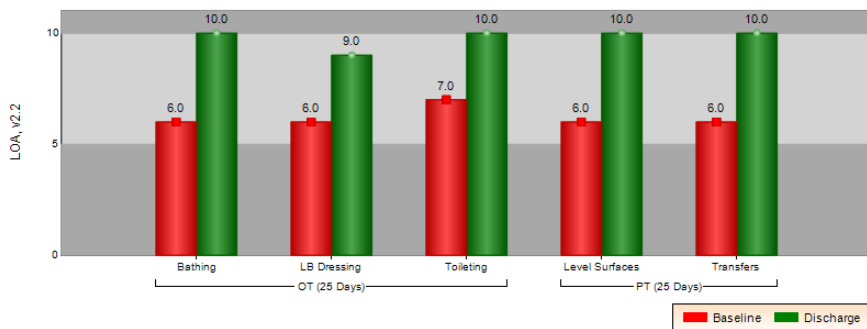

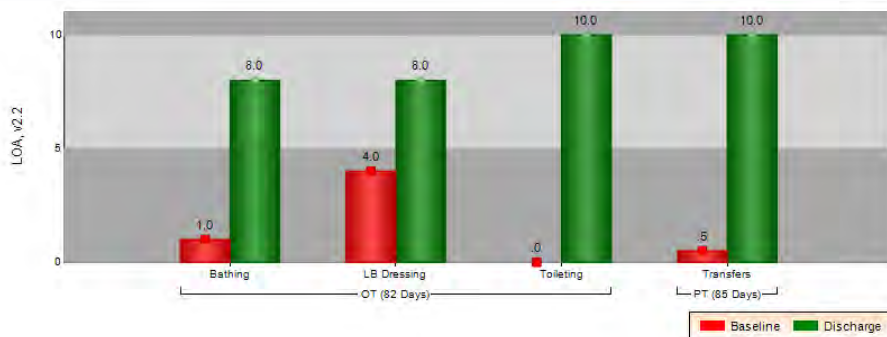

Cary was admitted to AristaCare at Park Avenue Rehab after recent onset of decrease in strength, transfers and mobility due to non healing wound to amputation site. Cary received Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy 5 – 7 days per week to address functional mobility, self care, and safety skills. Cary achieved his Speech Therapy goals of problem solving, medication management, divided attention, memory, recall, sequencing and safety with swallowing. In Occupational Therapy he was able to demonstrate independence with sponge bathing, dressing, bed mobility and hygiene/grooming tasks through increased upper body strength and endurance training. He required contact guard to supervision with bathing in shower/tub and toileting tasks. Physical Therapy focused with Cary on lower body and trunk strengthening, transfers, balance as well as improved safety and independence with unipedal hopping. Cary achieved his goals and was able to return home with family

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
